



Frequently Asked Questions:

Can the work endure weather?

Each one of our pieces is fine to sit outside in the sun or rain. In fact, the rain actually forms a meniscus on the surface of the inflatable and makes it even more air tight!

If the **winds exceed 60KMPH** or there's particularly bad weather - the works must be switched off

Can people touch the work?

Yes literally hundreds of thousands of people have touched our works. Touching is fine, but rough play ruins the experience for everyone and must be strongly discouraged. We suggest putting a "Don't touch" just to slow people down (even though they will still touch it)

What if the work gets dirty?

You can just use a normal household laundry spray and a scratchy sponge to spot clean the works. Don't use bleach!

How do we pack down the works at night?

At night, just turn the works off at the power, and let them deflate. We keep a specially made cover inside each work which easily zippers onto the base when not in use. The works end up looking like big black pancakes.
